HOW TO GIVE

- 1. Complete the Donor Information portion of the form.
- 2. Select from the list of participating nonprofit organizations and designate amounts for each organization.
- 3. Total all your contributions and write a single check payable to Capital Area United Way.
- 4. Mail or deliver Donor Form to Capital Area United Way by 5 p.m. on November 30.

IT'S THAT EASY

CAUW will process your gift, mail a tax receipt, and pass along 100 percent of your contribution to the organization(s) you choose.

Donations made by check are NOT eligible for Challenge Fund prizes on December 1 but do count toward the organization's proportional share percentage.

All gifts will be entered manually and reflected on each nonprofit's page on December 1.

This form must be completed for each donor transaction that will not be made at 225GIVES.org.
