



STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR SETTING UP A FUNDRAISER TO SUPPORT YOUR FAVORITE NONPROFIT!

Nonprofts are the heart and soul of our region – enriching our communities in ways no one else can. Do you have a favorite nonprofit? Does their work or their people inspire you to do good? Help them by setting up a fundraiser on their behalf!


1. Visit www.northstategives.org and click on "Participating Nonprofits"




2. In the search bar, type the name of the nonprofit you wish to support with a fundraiser.




When you see your preferred nonprofit profile display, click on the logo of the organization's profile.



In reaching the nonprofit profile, you'll click the "Fundraise" button in the upper right corner of the screen.




Upon first visit, each person will need to create a log-in in order to create fundraisers to support their favorite nonprofit unless there is an existing donor account. Click the "Create Profile" button if no account exists to create your new log-in. Otherwise, enter your credentials for your previously created donor account.




Please continue creating a log-in by entering all requested information. Log-in information should reflect the information of the person setting up the fundraiser. Once complete, click "Create Profile".

*Please note, if a nonprofit representative account already exists with an email address, another email address must be used to set-up the fundraiser account UNLESS the nonprofit would like to set up a fundraiser themselves. In that case, a nonprofit user can create a fundraising campaign by accessing the nonprofit dashboard and creating on there.



Upon successful completion of a fundraiser account, a Fundraiser Dashboard will appear. Most importantly, you will want to complete all information requested in the "My Fundraisers" tab. Once complete, you'll click the "Publish My Fundraiser" button and your fundraising campaign will be live and your supported nonprofit will receive an email notification of your campaign.




You can customize each field as you'd like though there is default language to help guide you. Please visit Appendix A for prompts that may help guide you.


Default title: Join {Fundraiser's First Name} in supporting {Imported Nonprofit of Choice} today!

Default summary: Join me in supporting {Nonprofit of Choice}, whose work builds a strong and vibrant community. Your donation will help this organization to fulfill its mission, and support a cause that is very close to my heart.

Default Personal Appeal: Your gift can make a real impact!




If you've elected to "Save" your campaign without publishing it, you can always return to it at a later date and finish. Bright red text near the top will let you know that your campaign is not yet published. To edit or publish the campaign, simply click on your desired option of "Publish My Fundraiser" or "Edit".




Once live, you'll see your account list the status of your fundraiser as "Approved - Current".

You'll also be able to click on an option to "See Donors to your Fundraiser" as donations are made to your campaign in support of your favorite nonprofit. You will see donor name, amount, and contact information populate. Given that you likely know these folks, a note of thanks to them is considered a best practice. They'll also receive an automatic receipt and a note of thanks from the nonprofit.



Your fundraiser will be live and showing on the www.northstategives.org site. From the homepage, you can click "Participating Nonprofits", then click "Fundraisers" to find your fundraising campaign and others. Feel free to share the link to your Fundraiser in direct emails/social media posts/etc.



<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If at any time your fundraising campaign is deemed disruptive or of concern by the nonprofit, they may reach out to you and discuss discontinuing your campaign.

APPENDIX A

PEER-TO-PEER FUNDRAISER QUESTIONS

Use these questions to prompt responses when creating a fundraiser

Describe your very first experience with [ORGANIZATION].
Why did you get involved with [ORGANIZATION]? How long have you been involved?
Do you know anyone who has directly benefited from our work?
Why do you donate to [ORGANIZATION]?
Why do you think other people should give to [ORGANIZATION]?
Have you had staff, volunteer or member inspire you?
Do you have a fun or funny story about some aspect of your work with us?
What value to you think [ORGANIZATION] adds to the community?
