# As of 6pm Today, Arizona Gives Day 2021 Has Raised More Than \$4 Million for 1000-Plus Nonprofits, Donations are Still Needed

PHOENIX, AZ — As of 6 p.m. today, Arizona Gives Day 2021, hosted by the Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits and Arizona Grantmakers Forum and presented by FirstBank, has raised more than \$4million for more than 1,040 nonprofit organizations statewide. Last year, the event raised a record \$6.1 million.

Nearly 27,000 individuals have donated on Arizona Gives Day, the annual statewide day of giving when Arizonans show their incredible support for their favorite local causes. At the same time, more than 1,100 volunteers have pledged almost 50,000 hours.

"The pace of giving, both financially and for volunteer hours, has been remarkable," said Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits CEO Kristen Merrifield. "There's no way to predict where the total will end up, but we're certainly on track for another great result."

- \$160,000 in prize pool money is up for grabs by participating nonprofits; 84 prizes will be given out ranging from \$500 \$7,500
