



NPO (Nonprofit Organization) Eligibility & Registration Requirements

Eligible Organizations for the Fremont Area Big Give must:

- Be tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and eligible to receive tax deductible donations,
- Be the only organization applying to participate under a specific 501(c)(3) tax ID number,
- Have a visible presence and provide services that directly impact the Fremont and/or Dodge County area,
- Use monies raised through the event for programs and services directly impacting the Fremont/Dodge County area,
- Be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations including, but not limited to, the USA Patriot Act and all applicable anti-terrorist financing and asset control laws,
- Meet federal filing requirements for tax-exempt organizations,
- Be governed by a body such as a board of directors, board of trustees, etc.,
- Not provide any benefit or privilege to a donor in return for his/her donation made in conjunction with the Fremont Area Big Give day,
- Comply with the Terms of Participation for the Fremont Area Big Give as outlined by the Fremont Area Community Foundation.
