# REGISTRATION OPENS TODAY FOR NATION'S LARGEST COMMUNITY GIVING DAY THAT TURNS 10 ON SEPTEMBER 20, HIGHLIGHTED BY 10 DAYS OF GIVING AND VOLUNTEERING, NEW TECHNOLOGY, AND MORE COUNTIES AND NONPROFIT CATEGORIES

# Former First Lady Laura Bush Joins as Inaugural Honorary Chair

**DALLAS** – (May 30, 2018) – Turning 10 is a big deal, especially for the nation's biggest community day of giving, which this year will occur September 20. Communities Foundation of Texas will mark North Texas Giving Day's milestone year with a slew of newness and improvements, ranging from a new platform that enables personalized crowdfunding, an ambassador program to spread the word and increase participation, four new qualifying counties that expand the service area to the Red River, the ability for PTAs and churches to participate, and 10 days of volunteering and scheduled giving from September 10-19.

**Additionally, former First Lady of the United States Laura Bush** will rally givers for North Texas Giving Day this year as the event's first honorary chair.

Registration for nonprofits to benefit on North Texas Giving Day opens May 30, coinciding with the annual series of nonprofit kick-offs that begin the same day. Registration closes August 15, 2018.
